

Epoxy Flooring Conditions

INHERENT INTRICACIES TO NOTE WHEN SELECTING YOUR EPOXY FLOORS:

METALLIC EPOXY FLOORS:

- Colors & special effects shown on samples and color charts are approximate and may not show full variation.
- Due to their highly unique and one of a kind nature, the overall appearance is subject to variations dependant on light, floor substrate, and finishing techniques.
- Metallic Epoxy Flooring can/will show comet like tails throughout the coating, this may not be apparent in samples or pictures of the flooring.
- If going over an existing tile floor, the old grout lines may shadow through the coating.

SOLID COLOR EPOXY FLOORS:

- If the floor is shot blasted, please note that blast lines could shadow through the coating
- If going over an existing tile floor, the old grout lines my shadow through the coating.

FULL FLAKE BROADCAST EPOXY FLOORS

• Full Flake Broadcast Epoxy Floors generally have a bumpy (orange peel) finish due to the nature of how the flakes lay out.

^{***}Although we use hepa filtered vacuums/dust collectors and keep the floor as clean as possible, we cannot be responsible for any air borne dust particles that settle into the finish epoxy during the curing process. These particles may cause pimple like bumps on the surface of the finish coating of all epoxy floors.
