

## **Cork Flooring Care + Maintenance Guide**

Thank you for choosing Capozza Floor Covering Center for your cork flooring project. To help ensure the look and longevity of your new cork floor, we have compiled the following recommendations for its proper care. Manufacturer's instructions will supersede the below information should the instructions differ.

- Sweep and/or vacuum often. Do not use bars while vacuuming. Keep vacuum wheels free from abrasive materials.
- Cork flooring can be cleaned with a damp mop and a cleaner made for wood flooring. Wet mopping or excessive water should be avoided.
- Cork Flooring should not be exposed to direct sunlight, as this can cause the cork's color to lighten. Lightening can be reduced with windows treated with a UV protectant.
- Felt furniture foot pads are recommended to help protect the finish of your cork flooring. Additionally, furniture coasters can help prevent denting of the flooring caused by heavy furniture. Should indentation occur from heavy objects, remove the object from the dent and be patient cork flooring will come back on its own.
- Help to prevent scratching by using walk off mats at exterior doors and keeping your pet's nails trimmed. Also, wearing spiked heals or sporting shoes (cleats, golf shoes, etc.) on the cork flooring can cause damage.
