

Linoleum Flooring Care + Maintenance Guide

Thank you for choosing Capozza Floor Covering Center for your linoleum flooring project. To help ensure the look and longevity of your new linoleum, we have compiled the following recommendations for its proper care. **Manufacturer's instructions will supersede the below information should the instructions differ.**

- Once installed, refrain from any cleaning for three (3) days.
- Sweep or vacuum often to remove loose debris and dust.
- Do not use excessive water or abrasive cleaners on your linoleum. Instead, we recommend damp mopping with a microfiber mop and neutral floor cleaner made for linoleum. These cleaners are available in our showroom.
- Felt furniture foot pads and coasters are recommended to help protect the finish of your linoleum. Floor protectors should be used under furniture with castor wheels.
- Help to prevent scratching by using walk off mats at exterior doors and keeping your pet's
 nails trimmed. Also, wearing spiked heals or sporting shoes (cleats, golf shoes, etc.) on the
 linoleum flooring can cause damage.
